ARMY INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT, KOLKATA RESUME OF EVENTS / ACTIVITIES : APRIL 2020

Overview

1. The month of April saw the institute settling down in the CoVid lockdown mode of functioning with its attendant challenges and uncertainties. The online mode of teaching-learning was adopted in earnest. The list of successful candidates for the next academic session (MBA-24) was promulgated on 06 Apr. Our recommendations for review of the establishment of the Institute were staffed, as also a proposal was mooted to generate funds by monetizing our idle assets by considering a request from Institute of Management Technology (IMT), Ghaziabad to set up their Regional Learning Support Centre within our campus for their distance education programme. Should the need arise HQ Eastern Command is considering setting up a quarantine facility at our new campus. In this connection, The Eastern Army Commander visited the new campus on 14 Apr. To assist the Command Hospital next door, accommodation has been provided for some doctors and medical stores in our campus since 09 Apr. Sanitization protocols within the institute have been strengthened. After completing his tenure of nearly five years Col Sushen Chakraborty (Retd) bid farewell to the Institute on 30 Apr. The Director briefed the Chairman Maj Gen Satbir Singh, SM** on 22 Apr at his Headquarters. The Chairman had earlier assumed the appointment in the last week of Mar.

Academics

2. <u>Online Classes</u>. Online classes, as per a schedule; were launched by the faculty members working from home with effect from 30 Mar (Some faculty members had started taking online classes even earlier. There are challenges of connectivity and network speeds being experienced by the students & the faculty. The Institute would be investing in developing digital content to make the experience more wholesome. The syllabus has been covered / completed in case of most of the subjects. In the normal course semester exams commence in end May / early June.

3. <u>AIMS Bengal Chapter Online Conference (03 Apr)</u>. Director attended an online conference of the Association of Indian Management Schools (AIMS) West Bengal Chapter on 03 Apr. The impact and responses to the CoVid pandemic on management education and practice was shared by the participants.

4. <u>Admission MBA 24 : Online Group Discussion (GD) / Personal Interview (PI) (01 & 02 Apr)</u>. The online round of inerviews was rescheduled from 26/27 Mar and conducted on 01/02 Apr. 14 candidates (Army:09, General:05) appeared for the online interview. The First List of successful candidates was promulgated on 06 Apr. 102 candidates (Army : 85, General : 17) have deposited the first installment of fees by 30 Apr. The second online round is scheduled in end May.

<u>Placements</u>

5. <u>Placement Status (MBA 22)</u>. Byjus conducted tele interviews during the month of Apr and picked up two of our HR students, taking the number of students placed to 108. The details of placements in Mar 2020 are as under:-

Administration

- 12. <u>Visit Patron-in-Chief and Army Commander to New Campus (14 Apr)</u>. Patron in Chief and Eastern Army Commander visited our New Campus to consider its feasibility as a quarantine facility, should the need arise. He was conducted by the Chairman and Director.
- 13. <u>Briefing Chairman IGB / IMC (22 Apr)</u>. The Director briefed the Chairman, Maj Gen Satbir Singh, SM** on 22 Apr at his Headquarters. The Chairman had earlier assumed the appointment in the last week of Mar.
- 14. <u>Establishment: End of Term Col Sushen Chakraborty (30 Apr)</u>. After almost five years in chair, Col Sushen Chakraborty (Retd) our Registrar and Head of Administration bid farewell to AIMK. Col Chakraborty's relief is expected in Jun 20. A request for his extension until then was turned down and the Placement Officer has since been nominated to officiate in the interim.
- 15. <u>Establishment: PA to Director (27 Apr)</u>. Sub Tushar Pattnayak (Retd) assumed the duties of PA to Director on 27 Apr. The extended term of the previous PA Shri Tarak Sarkar expired on 30 Apr and he had not been coming to the office since the Lockdown began in mid Mar.
- 16. <u>Infrastructure at New Campus</u>. While work at the New Campus remains suspended, work on provision of external services (electricity & water) was completed on 10 Apr.
- 17. <u>Lockdown & Implications</u>. The Institute entered Lockdown 2.0 on 14 Apr for an additional period of 3 weeks. Lockdown protocol measures have been further strengthened. Our present campus within the Command Hospital premises (and proximity to Khidirpur & Mominpur) is likely to remain a hot spot or within a containment zone for long. Hence, it would be in the best interests of the Institute to re-locate to the New Campus at Rajarhat partly or fully at the earliest available opportunity.
- 18. <u>Accounts / Finance</u>. Owing to the lockdown and non-attendance of office by accounts staff, ad-hoc salaries were paid to the staff for the second month in running on 21 Apr.
