Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers Ltd.



The Institute organized an industrial visit for MBA-20 batch which was about the management and working conditions of **GRSE** on **08th Sept, 2016**.

Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers Ltd, is one of India's leading shipyard, located in Kolkata, West Bengal. It builds and repairs commercial and naval vessels. Presently GRSE has also started building ships for exporting purpose in a mission to expand its business.

The visit was followed by warm welcome from **Miss Sonali Purti Assistant HR.** After that students were introduced to the Deputy Managers of three different departments.

- 1. **Plate Preparation Department Mr. Tanmoy Mondal, Deputy Manger** of the said department introduced them to the basics of preparation and processing of plate used for construction of warships. The whole process includes stocking of raw material then straightening, painting and cutting of plates using CNC machines.
- 2. **Ship Building Shop Mr. Ajay Thakur, Deputy Manager** of the said department explained briefly about material sorting, block fabrication i.e. welding and fitting job, and then the test for structurally sound body using X-RAY.
- 3. New Facility Area Mr. Ajit Bikram, Deputy Manager of the said department told us about the management of the heavy overhead cranes and also the importance of dry dock and wet dock. This facility is built on a new inclined berth. He also discussed about the safety of the equipments and workers working condition.

After the departmental briefing of warship construction, a presentation on GRSE about its vision, mission and CSR was shown. A great learning experience for our budding managers.
